What do we do?

- Run a mentoring scheme! Launched January 2018
- Match less experienced RP professionals with senior members (ideally in a similar field) who are able to offer advice and guidance via suitable communication means (e.g. phone, e-mail, or face-to-face meetings).
- Mentors aim to support mentees with their learning and development for an agreed period (e.g. 12 months)
- Mentoring may include help with a particular project or problem, guidance during a course of study where no other suitable mentor is available, advice on career progression or assistance with a paper publication, a conference poster, or a competition entry.
