Klaus Henrichs studied (Atomic) Physics (diploma), he then obtained his doctorate in cancer research. After some years in clinical research (degree "medical physics expert") he worked for 10 years in the field of dosimetry mainly in the context of workers safety.

Afterwards he changed into industry starting with worldwide responsibility in radiation safety for a large globally active company (Siemens). He finished his



industrial career as vice-president for safety with Siemens. During 2012 to 2014 he there was mainly responsible for a safety related global culture change program.

Following two years of presidency in 2000/2001 since 2004 Klaus Henrichs is engaged as secretary of the German-Swiss Association for Radiation Protection ("Fachverband"). He initiated and coordinates the cooperation of the European IRPA societies. In 2014, he was the president of the European Regional IRPA Congress in Geneva. He is also member of the Austrian Society. Together with Alfred Hefner he initiated in the last years the Young Scientists competition, the first time hold internationally at the 13th IRPA Conference in May 2012 in Glasgow.
