Dr. Sara Dumit is a scientist at Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL), where she completed her postdoctoral research. She has authored and co-authored over 50 scientific publications and abstracts in the field of radiation protection and has presented her research more than 50 times at national and international conferences, including as an invited speaker at esteemed scientific gatherings.

Dr. Dumit has an impressive record of professional service, including roles as an associate editor for the Health Physics Journal, chair of the Health Physics Society's Public Information Committee, member of the Program Area Committee 7 of the National Council on Radiation Protection and Measurements (NCRP), member-intern with the



International Commission on Radiological Protection's Scientific Secretariat, and as a member of the U.S. delegation to IRPA16.

Her achievements have been recognized through several prestigious awards, including the 2022 Elda E. Anderson Award from the Health Physics Society, the 2022 John D. Boice, Jr. Young Investigator Award from the NCRP, and the 2024 Carl Storm Fellowship from the Gordon Research Conference (Metals in Medicine). Dr. Dumit is also a Lindau Nobel Laureate Meeting Young Scientist (Alumna for 2022 and 2021), and a Young Leader of the Science and Technology in Society Forum (2024).
